**GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS**

1. The West Virginia Horse Expo Extreme Cowboy Race is an Extreme Cowboy Association sanctioned event. Therefore, EXCA rules shall govern the event.
2. All exhibitors shall make themselves familiar with the rules of the EXCA.
3. All Extreme Cowboy Race exhibitors must complete registration and pay registration fee. **Registrations must be received by April 1, 2010.**
4. All exhibitors must sign in upon arrival at the expo to receive their Welcome Package which will contain their competition number.
5. At sign in, exhibitors must display their EXCA member card, become a EXCA member or pay a nonmember fee.
6. All exhibitor's horses must be current on vaccination and have a negative Coggins Test.
7. **All exhibitors will be required to present their negative Coggins Test at the gate. If you do not have your paperwork, your horse(s) will not be allowed on the grounds.**
8. Any horse deemed unfit (in poor condition, lame etc.) will not be allowed to compete in the race.
9. WV HE Management reserves the right to reject the application of or request the removal of any contestant who is deemed offensive.
10. Video and photos taken by WVHE Management are the property of WVHE Management.
11. WVHE Management shall provide security throughout setup, the event, and breakdown. However, WVHE Management shall NOT be responsible for contestants' personal items left on the grounds.
12. WVHE Management makes no representations or guarantees as to the number of attendees to the WVHE nor does WVHE Management guarantee any financial gain to contestant.
13. WVHE Management shall NOT be held liable for any damages or financial losses if the event is delayed or canceled due to circumstances beyond the control of management (i.e. acts of God, governmental emergency, or bomb threat). Should such a cancellation take place, WVHE Management may retain some of the amount paid by contestants to defray the cost to date that management has incurred in producing the event. The balance to be paid to contestant within 30 days of cancellation.
14. The West Virginia Horse Expo is a Social Enterprise of Arms Wide Open Ministries, Inc. (AWOM). Contestants agree to indemnify and hold harmless West Virginia Horse Expo and its organizers, AWOM, TAHOE, and the State Fair Event Center also referred to as management, organizers and venue, their agents, officers, volunteers and employees from all claims, losses, damages, or expense resulting or arising from any and all injuries to or death of any person or damage to any property caused by an act, omission, or neglect of management, organizers, venue, contestants, contractors or attendees.
15. Although not required, it is strongly recommended that each contestant, at its own expense procure and maintain in force liability insurance.
16. Contestants shall abide by and observe all federal, state, and local codes, ordinances and laws.
17. Contestants shall also comply with the rules and regulations of the venue, the State Fair Event Center. All materials, equipment, and utensils used in the Cowboy Cook-Off must meet West Virginia Fire Code regulations.
18. Should any Contestant fail to abide by these terms and conditions/rules and regulations Set forth in this agreement, WVHE Management reserves the right to terminate the contestant's contract and refuse the contestant's participation in future events produced by the WVHE Management.
